DAY TRIP 1 - CHRISTCHURCH

Christchurch, located in the province (region) of Canterbury, is the largest city in the South Island, yet remains a friendly and welcoming city compact enough to easily explore on foot or bicycle.

Following the 2010-2011 earthquakes, Christchurch has re-emerged as a vibrant, ever-changing city that Lonely Planet has listed it as one of the top 10 cities to visit in 2013.

There is so much to see and do in the city, with new restaurants, bars, retail spaces and art popping up all the time. This is a great time to visit as the city changes shape almost every day – there's always something new to discover!

Visit the Christchurch Botanic Gardens

The Christchurch Botanic Gardens, one of the largest central city parks in the world, showcases the flora of New Zealand and afar. Founded in 1863 with the planting of an English Oak tree, the Gardens now features one of the finest collections of exotic and native plants found in New Zealand. Take time to explore the gardens, which are considered to be an oasis in the city of Christchurch with 21 hectares of horticultural displays, several conservatories, memorials, garden art and walking tracks.

A picturesque 90-minute drive from Christchurch lies Akaroa, a charming French inspired port cradled in the arms of an ancient volcano. Take in sweeping harbour views and see the outer bays from a hilltop vantage point. In the village itself, spend a leisurely day exploring boutique shops, galleries and gourmet eateries, or par take in one of the many nature tours on offer, such as swimming or viewing the rare hector dolphins or kayaking through the penguin colony.


